

MOVING-OUT CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

When you hand over the apartment, it should be as clean and tidy as it was when you moved in.

Kitchen

- Clean the stove, oven, oven racks and oven trays
- Clean the refrigerator/freezer, both inside and outside
- Defrost the freezer
- Clean the kitchen cupboards and drawers, wipe the doors also
- Clean and empty the trash cans and cupboard
- Clean the sink unit and sink
- Clean the extractor hood

Toilet, bathroom/sauna

- Clean the toilet seat, handbasin, shower cubicle walls and, if the apartment includes a sauna, the sauna benches
- Clean the cupboards
- Clean the floor drain(s)
- When disconnecting the washing machine, remember to block the water and drain connections

General/other living spaces

- Hoover all floor surfaces and wipe them with a wet cloth
- Wipe any scratches or stains on door or wall surfaces with a wet cloth
- Wipe the light switches
- Clean all wardrobes and shelves as well as the wardrobe doors, both inside and outside
- Clean the windows, season permitting
- Clean the rails of the sliding doors

Storage and other spaces

- Empty and tidy up the terrace/balcony, storage, front yard and back yard. Cut the grass of the yard area

Remember!

Only regular household waste belongs in the household waste collection point. Superfluous furniture or household appliances should not be placed either in the property's waste collection points, the communal spaces of the building or the apartment. Instead, you should deliver such items to a waste recycling point (such as Sortti).
